



## Voting Results of the Extraordinary Session of the IUGS-IGC Council

The Extraordinary Session of the IUGS-IGC Council was held on 28-30 October 2020, during which the new IUGS Executive Committee and Nominating Committee for the term 2020-2024 were elected and reports of IUGS Officers and Committees, resolutions and survey on the Rescheduled 36<sup>th</sup> IGC were also voted on. All the voting results of the Extraordinary Session are as follows:

### 1. Executive Committee

#### (1) President
